



Aluminum Can Donation Volunteer

Collecting donated aluminum cans is an important income source for Hospitality House of Owatonna, Inc. HHO has a great need for a group of individuals to volunteer their time to help HHO with the can donation process. This would be scheduled for Tuesdays and Fridays each week. Volunteers would work with the Program Manager and/or House Operations Chair to ensure completion.

Volunteer(s) are responsible for:

- Monitor can donation trailer levels 2-3 times a week
- Take can trailer from its designated collecting spot to Owatonna Metal Recycling Center on a Tuesday and Friday schedule. (More than 1 group is encouraged to participate, resulting in 1 group a week instead of twice a week.)
- Sort through donated cans to ensure no unwanted materials get into the collection bins at the metal recycling facility.
- After can bins are weighed, collect HHO's check and provide it to the Program Manager.

Requirements:

- Must be over the age of 18.
- Must have a Valid Driver's License.
- Provide Proof of Insurance.
- Have a vehicle that has a ball and hitch to transport trailer.
- Be physically able to bend and lift at least 10 pounds.
